- Whom does God oppose and favor (4:6)?
- When does give us grace (4:6)?
- How did James describe how we should come to God (4:7-10)?
- How does the devil react when a person resists him (4:7)?
- What does God do to us when we have an attitude of humility before Him (4:10)?
- How are we to speak to one another (4:11)?
- When we speak against a fellow believer, what attitude are we having toward God and His law (4:11-12)?

- How have your beliefs about what God wants from you changed?
- How does pride show up in our work? Home? Church? Community?
- Who does God oppose proud people?
- What is the difference between pride and a sense of accomplishment?
- How can a person tell when they have become proud?

- What do we want from God most of the time?
- Why do we hesitate to give our lives to God?
